Fees, CCB and CCR Information

Fair Play Café is Child Care Benefit (CCB) and Child Care Rebate (CCR) approved, using your Centrelink Customer Reference Number (CRN) families can take advantage of assistance for child care from the federal government. Please Call Centrelink on 13 61 50 to enquire about CCB or CCR. They are open Monday to Friday from 8.30 am - 8pm.

Our meals are changed daily to ensure your children receive a wide variety of healthy and yummy food.

Fair Play Café understands that children may have special dietary requirements, all meals will be prepared to accommodate any needs of your child.

Cold water is also provided will every meal and children have free access to water at all times.
